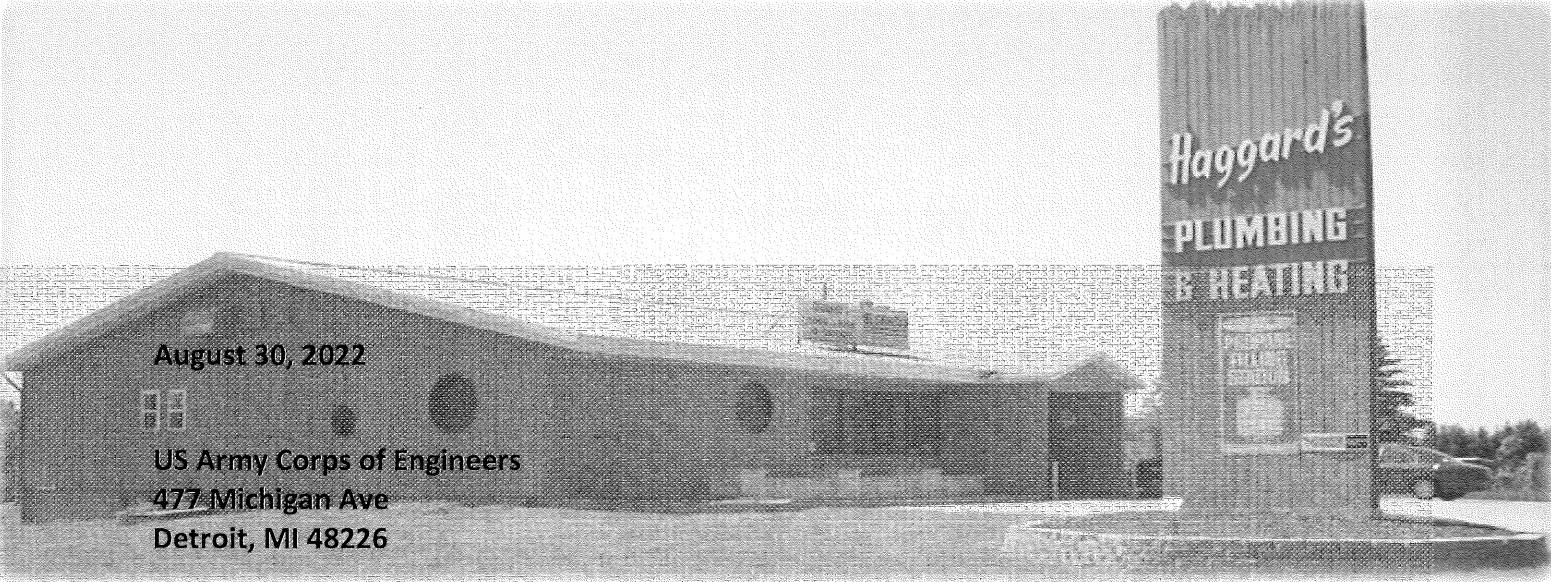

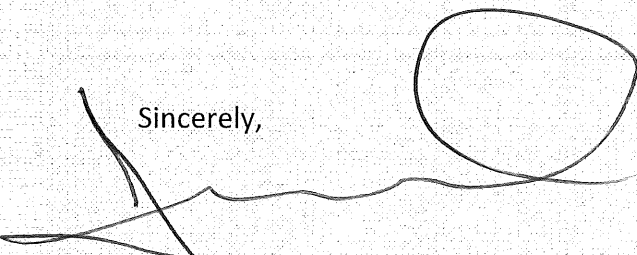
Ref: Enbridge Line 5 EIS, Public Comment
